I. KEY INDICATORS

- The Manufacture of tobacco products industry in Bulgaria was represented by 12 companies at the end of 2017, compared to 14 in the previous year and 19 in 2015.
- The industry's net loss amounted to BGN 16,446,000 in 2017.
- The industry's total revenue was BGN 693,646,000 in 2017, down by 10.23% compared to the previous year.
- The combined costs of the companies in the Manufacture of tobacco products industry reached BGN 708,845,000 in 2017, down by 7.99% year-on-year.
- The industry's total revenue makes up 0.72% to the country's Gross domestic product (GDP) in 2017, compared to 0.83% for 2016 and 0.99% in 2015.
- A total of 2,020 people were employed in the Manufacture of tobacco products industry in 2017, compared to 2,364 in 2016 and 2,972 in 2015.
- Most of the companies in the industry are based in Sofia, followed by Radinovo and Blagoevgrad.

II. INTRODUCTION

In 2017 the companies in the Manufacture of tobacco products industry numbered 12.


In 2016 there were a total of 14 companies operating in the industry. In 2015 their number totalled 19.

III. REVENUES


The total revenue in the industry was BGN 693,646,000 in 2017, BGN 772,683,000 in 2016 and 884,840,000 in 2015.



The companies in the Manufacture of tobacco products market of Bulgaria earned combined net sales revenues of BGN 594,326,000 in 2017.

In annual terms, sales marked a decline of 3.62% compared to 2016. In comparison to 2015 they went down by 22.59%. In 2016 sales decreased by 19.68% year-on-year.

The Manufacture of tobacco products industry total revenue make up 0.72% to the country's GDP in 2017, compared to 0.83% for 2016 and 0.99% in 2015.



In 2017 the Manufacture of tobacco products industry contributed to GDP BGN 561,489,000 in Gross value added (GVA) accounting for 0.33% of the total for the country's economy.

In the previous year, the industry's GVA amounted BGN 620,367,000, accounting for 0.41% of the total for the

country in 2016. In 2015 the GVA of the Manufacture of tobacco products was BGN 775,643,000, or 0.50% of the GVA for the country's economy.

We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the total revenue of the Manufacture of tobacco products industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of -11.46% in 2018.

Manufacture of tobacco products contributed net sales revenue of BGN 594,326,000 or 100.00% of the total net sales in the industry.

There was no industry's sector to report a growth in net sales revenues. In terms of annual drop, the top position was occupied by Manufacture of tobacco products with 3.62%.

The top 10 companies in terms of total revenue in Manufacture of tobacco products accounted for 99.89% of the industry's total in 2017, 99.32% in 2016 and 99.61% in 2015.

The total revenues of the top 10 companies in the Manufacture of tobacco products were 0.72% of GDP in 2017, compared to 0.83% for 2016 and 0.99% in 2015.

The top 10 by assets in the Manufacture of tobacco products market made up BGN 591,766,000, or 99.57% of the total net sales revenue.



The 10 largest companies in terms of total revenue in sector Manufacture of tobacco products earned total revenue of BGN 692,906,000 and accounted for 99.89% of the industry's total revenue.

IV. EXPENSES

The combined costs of the companies in the Manufacture of tobacco products industry reached BGN 708,845,000 in 2017.



In annual terms, total expenses went down by 7.99% compared to 2016 and went down by 17.27% in comparison to 2015.

The total operating expenses of the companies in the



Manufacture of tobacco products industry were BGN 691,196,000 in 2017.

Operating costs dropped by 6.82% compared with the previous year and dropped by 16.64% when compared to 2015.

We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the total costs of the Manufacture of tobacco products industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of -9.04% in 2018.

Employment expenses in the Manufacture of tobacco products industry fell by 5.61% on the year to BGN 53,806,000 in 2017.



The monthly costs per employee in the Manufacture of tobacco products industry averaged BGN 2,220 in 2017, BGN 2,009 in 2016 and BGN 1,897 in 2015.

The monthly social security costs per employee in the industry averaged BGN 339 in 2017, versus BGN 263 in 2016 and BGN 256 in 2015.





The industry's tax expenses stood at BGN 1,247,000 in 2017. In 2016 it paid taxes of BGN 2,574,000. In 2015 the industry paid BGN 3,695,000 in taxes.



V. PROFITABILITY

The industry's net loss amounted to BGN 16,446,000 in 2017, compared to a net loss of BGN 285,000 in 2016 and a net profit of BGN 24,347,000 in 2015.



In 2017 the Manufacture of tobacco products industry swung to an operating loss of BGN 15,199,000 from an operating profit of BGN 2,289,000 in 2016.

The profit margin for the Manufacture of tobacco products industry stood at -2.45% in 2017, while in 2016 it amounted to 0.31% and 3.23% in 2015.

The Manufacture of tobacco products industry's return on equity (ROE) is -3.74% compared to -0.06% in 2016 and 4.77% in 2015.

The Manufacture of tobacco products's return on assets (ROA) was -1.17%, while in 2016 it amounted to -0.02% and 1.84% in 2015.

The average net sales revenue per employee in the Manufacture of tobacco products industry amounted to BGN 294,221 in 2017, up by 12.79% compared to 2016 and up by 13.90% compared to 2015.

The industry's average operating revenue per employee went down by 1.13% year-on-year in 2017 to BGN 307,657. It rose by 5.56% compared to 2015.

The Manufacture of tobacco products field generated an average BGN 343,389 in total revenue per employee. In 2016 and 2015 the figure was BGN 326,854 and BGN 297,725, respectively.

The average total revenue per company in the Manufacture of tobacco products industry rose to BGN 57,803,833 in 2017 from BGN 55,191,643 in 2016. The 2015 value was BGN 46,570,526.

A company in the Manufacture of tobacco products industry made on average a net sales revenue of BGN 49,527,167 in 2017, compared to BGN 44,046,357 in 2016 and BGN 40,406,737 in 2015.

The Manufacture of tobacco products industry made 0.22% of the overall sales country-wide, reducing its market share by 0.03 pp.

Operating profit per employee for the industry as a whole was BGN -7,524 in 2017. For comparison in 2016 it amounted to BGN 968 and BGN 968 in 2015.

The total indebtedness of the companies in the Manufacture of tobacco products industry was BGN 951,677,000 versus BGN 1,020,448,000 a year ago. In 2015 the industry's indebtedness totalled BGN 800,878,000.

Debt-to-assets ratio of the companies in the industry is 0.68 in 2017. It was 0.68 in 2016 and 0.61 in 2015.


According to market experts, the greatest impact on the development of the Manufacture of tobacco products industry has net sales revenue to production and land plots ratio. In 2017 it stood at 126, according to the financial statements of the companies in the industry. In 2016 the figure was 116 and 135 in 2015.

VI. EMPLOYMENT

A total of 2,020 people were employed in the Manufacture of tobacco products field at the end of 2017, compared to 2,364 in 2016 and 2,972 in 2015.

The analysis on companies' sizes by the number of employees, shows that 5 firms have less than 50 employees*, 3 have between 50 and 250 employees* and 3 companies employ more than 250*.

* Companies without data in the number of employees at end of the year are not taken into consideration.



The employees of the leading 10 companies in terms of numbers make up 99.80% of the workforce in the industry in 2017.

The Manufacture of tobacco products industry is the 70th largest employer in the country with 2,020 employees with the largest employer being Retail trade, except of motor vehicles and motorcycles with 200,534 and Extraction of crude petroleum and natural gas at the bottom with 27 employees.

The Manufacture of tobacco products's share in the country's total employment was 0.09% in 2017, 0.12% in 2016 and 0.15% in 2015.

We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the number of employees of the Manufacture of tobacco products industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of -17.56% in 2018.
