I. KEY INDICATORS

- The Remediation activities and other waste management services industry in Bulgaria was represented by 80 companies at the end of 2017, compared to 84 in the previous year and 75 in 2015.
- The industry's net profit amounted to BGN 11,437,000 in 2017.
- The industry's total revenue was BGN 144,508,000 in 2017, up by 3.25% compared to the previous year.
- The combined costs of the companies in the Remediation activities and other waste management services industry reached BGN 132,107,000 in 2017, down by 0.30% year-onyear.
- The industry's total revenue makes up 0.15% to the country's Gross domestic product (GDP) in 2017, compared to 0.15% for 2016 and 0.16% in 2015.
- A total of 1,059 people were employed in the Remediation activities and other waste management services industry in 2017, compared to 963 in 2016 and 909 in 2015.
- Most of the companies in the industry are based in Sofia, followed by Varna and Plovdiv.

II. INTRODUCTION

In 2017 the companies in the Remediation activities and other waste management services industry numbered 80.


In 2016 there were a total of 84 companies operating in the industry. In 2015 their number totalled 75.

III. REVENUES


The total revenue in the industry was BGN 144,508,000 in 2017, BGN 139,966,000 in 2016 and 143,582,000 in 2015.



The companies in the Remediation activities and other waste management services market of Bulgaria earned combined net sales revenues of BGN 132,675,000 in 2017.

In annual terms, sales marked a rise of 4.26% compared to 2016. In comparison to 2015 they dropped by 1.21%. In 2016 sales fell by 5.25% year-on-year.

The Remediation activities and other waste management services industry total revenue make up 0.15% to the country's GDP in 2017, compared to 0.15% for 2016 and 0.16% in 2015.



In 2017 the Remediation activities and other waste management services industry contributed to GDP BGN 120,965,000 in Gross value added (GVA) accounting for 0.07% of the total for the country's economy.

In the previous year, the industry's GVA amounted BGN 117,576,000, accounting for 0.08% of the total for the country

in 2016. In 2015 the GVA of the Remediation activities and other waste management services was BGN 122,306,000, or 0.08% of the GVA for the country's economy.

We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the total revenue of the Remediation activities and other waste management services industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 0.32% in 2018.

Remediation activities and other waste management services contributed net sales revenue of BGN 132,675,000 or 100.00% of the total net sales in the industry.

The highest growth, of 4.26%, was recorded by Remediation activities and other waste management services. There was no industry's sector to report a drop in net sales revenues.

The top 10 companies in terms of total revenue in Remediation activities and other waste management services accounted for 82.94% of the industry's total in 2017, 83.57% in 2016 and 87.76% in 2015.

The total revenues of the top 10 companies in the Remediation activities and other waste management services were 0.12% of GDP in 2017, compared to 0.13% for 2016 and 0.14% in 2015.

The top 10 by assets in the Remediation activities and other waste management services market made up BGN 60,587,000, or 45.67% of the total net sales revenue.



The 10 largest companies in terms of total revenue in sector Remediation activities and other waste management services earned total revenue of BGN 119,862,000 and accounted for 82.94% of the industry's total revenue.

IV. EXPENSES

The combined costs of the companies in the Remediation activities and other waste management services industry reached BGN 132,107,000 in 2017.




In annual terms, total expenses fell by 0.30% compared to 2016 and dropped by 3.08% in comparison to 2015.

The total operating expenses of the companies in the Remediation activities and other waste management services industry were BGN 130,805,000 in 2017.

Operating costs went down by 0.18% compared with the previous year and decreased by 3.36% when compared to 2015.

We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the total costs of the Remediation activities and other waste management services industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of -1.55% in 2018.

Employment expenses in the Remediation activities and other waste management services industry rose by 14.49% on the year to BGN 13,815,000 in 2017.



The highest growth in labour costs, of 14.49%, was registered by Remediation activities and other waste management services.

The monthly costs per employee in the Remediation activities and other waste management services industry averaged BGN 1,087 in 2017, BGN 1,044 in 2016 and BGN 1,034 in 2015.

The monthly social security costs per employee in the industry averaged BGN 150 in 2017, versus BGN 148 in 2016 and BGN 158 in 2015.





The industry's tax expenses stood at BGN 964,000 in 2017. In 2016 it paid taxes of BGN 862,000. In 2015 the industry paid BGN 725,000 in taxes.



V. PROFITABILITY

The industry's net profit amounted to BGN 11,437,000 in 2017, compared to a net profit of BGN 6,606,000 in 2016 and a net profit of BGN 6,551,000 in 2015.


The combined operating earnings of the companies in the Remediation activities and other waste management services market grew by 66.06% y/y to BGN 12,401,000 in 2017.

The profit margin for the Remediation activities and other waste management services industry stood at 8.62% in 2017, while in 2016 it amounted to 5.36% and 5.07% in 2015.

The Remediation activities and other waste management services industry's return on equity (ROE) is 19.67% compared

to 11.77% in 2016 and 13.69% in 2015.

The Remediation activities and other waste management services's return on assets (ROA) was 7.95%, while in 2016 it amounted to 6.05% and 7.12% in 2015.

About 30.00% of the 10 leading companies in terms of net profit per employee are located in SOFIA, while 20.00% are PLOVDIV-based and 10.00% are headquartered in GALABOVO.

The average net sales revenue per employee in the Remediation activities and other waste management services industry amounted to BGN 125,283 in 2017, down by 5.19% compared to 2016 and down by 15.20% compared to 2015.

The industry's average operating revenue per employee dropped by 6.02% year-on-year in 2017 to BGN 135,870. It fell by 13.84% compared to 2015.

The Remediation activities and other waste management services field generated an average BGN 136,457 in total revenue per employee. In 2016 and 2015 the figure was BGN 145,344 and BGN 157,956, respectively.

The average total revenue per company in the Remediation activities and other waste management services industry grew

to BGN 1,806,350 in 2017 from BGN 1,666,262 in 2016. The 2015 value was BGN 1,914,427.

A company in the Remediation activities and other waste management services field made on average a net sales revenue of BGN 1,658,438 in 2017, compared to BGN 1,514,905 in 2016 and BGN 1,790,613 in 2015.

The Remediation activities and other waste management services industry made 0.05% of the overall sales countrywide.

Operating profit per employee for the industry as a whole was BGN 11,710 in 2017. For comparison in 2016 it amounted to BGN 7,755 and BGN 7,755 in 2015.

The total indebtedness of the companies in the Remediation activities and other waste management services industry was BGN 83,388,000 versus BGN 50,703,000 a year ago. In 2015 the industry's indebtedness totalled BGN 41,882,000.

Debt-to-assets ratio of the companies in the industry is 0.58 in 2017. It was 0.46 in 2016 and 0.46 in 2015.

According to market experts, the greatest impact on the development of the Remediation activities and other waste management services industry has operating profit / loss. In 2017 it stood at BGN 12,401,000, according to the financial statements of the companies in the industry. In 2016 the figure was BGN 7,468,000 and BGN 7,267,000 in 2015.

VI. EMPLOYMENT

A total of 1,059 people were employed in the Remediation activities and other waste management services sector at the end of 2017, compared to 963 in 2016 and 909 in 2015.

The analysis on companies' sizes by the number of employees, shows that 47 firms have less than 50 employees*, 4 have between 50 and 250 employees* and 1 companies employ more than 250*.

We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the number of employees of the Remediation activities and other waste management services industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 7.94% in 2018.
