I. KEY INDICATORS

- The Water collection, treatment and supply industry in Bulgaria was represented by 65 companies at the end of 2016, compared to 69 in the previous year and 76 in 2014.
- The industry's net profit amounted to BGN 30,881,000 in 2016.
- The industry's total revenue was BGN 694,280,000 in 2016, up by 3.18% compared to the previous year.
- The combined costs of the companies in the Water collection, treatment and supply industry reached BGN 659,906,000 in 2016, up by 3.06% year-on-year.
- The industry's total revenue makes up 0.75% to the country's Gross domestic product (GDP) in 2016, compared to 0.75% for 2015 and 0.75% in 2014.
- A total of 16,861 people were employed in the Water collection, treatment and supply industry in 2016, compared to 26,624 in 2015 and 17,034 in 2014.
- Most of the companies in the industry are based in Sofia, followed by Velingrad and Batak.

II. INTRODUCTION

In 2016 the companies in the Water collection, treatment and supply industry numbered 65.

In 2015 there were a total of 69 companies operating in the industry. In 2014 their number totalled 76.


The total revenue in the industry was BGN 694,280,000 in 2016, BGN 672,914,000 in 2015 and 642,447,000 in 2014.

The companies in the Water collection, treatment and supply market of Bulgaria earned combined net sales revenues of BGN 598,794,000 in 2016.

In annual terms, sales marked a rise of 3.90% compared to 2015. In comparison to 2014 they rose by 8.65%. In 2015 sales rose by 4.58% year-on-year.

The Water collection, treatment and supply industry total revenue make up 0.75% to the country's GDP in 2016, compared to 0.75% for 2015 and 0.75% in 2014.



In 2016 the Water collection, treatment and supply industry contributed to GDP BGN 631,986,000 in Gross value added (GVA) accounting for 0.41% of the total for the country's economy.

In the previous year, the industry's GVA amounted BGN 621,894,000, accounting for 0.40% of the total for the

country in 2015. In 2014 the GVA of the Water collection, treatment and supply was BGN 584,641,000, or 0.41% of the GVA for the country's economy.

We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the total revenue of the Water collection, treatment and supply industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 3.96% in 2017.

Water collection, treatment and supply contributed net sales revenue of BGN 598,794,000 or 100.00% of the total net sales in the industry.

The highest growth, of 3.90%, was recorded by Water collection, treatment and supply. There was no industry's sector to report a drop in net sales revenues.

The top 10 companies in terms of total revenue in Water collection, treatment and supply accounted for 68.17% of the industry's total in 2016, 67.58% in 2015 and 67.73% in 2014.

The total revenues of the top 10 companies in the Water collection, treatment and supply were 0.51% of GDP in 2016, compared to 0.51% for 2015 and 0.51% in 2014.

The top 10 by assets in the Water collection, treatment and supply sector made up BGN 386,655,000, or 64.57% of the total net sales revenue.



The 10 largest companies in terms of total revenue in sector Water collection, treatment and supply earned total revenue of BGN 473,324,000 and accounted for 68.17% of the industry's total revenue.

IV. EXPENSES

The combined costs of the companies in the Water collection, treatment and supply industry reached BGN 659,906,000 in 2016.




In annual terms, total expenses grew by 3.06% compared to 2015 and went up by 5.22% in comparison to 2014.

The total operating expenses of the companies in the Water collection, treatment and supply industry were BGN 643,410,000 in 2016.

Operating costs increased by 2.42% compared with the previous year and grew by 4.88% when compared to 2014.

We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the total costs of the Water collection, treatment and supply industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 2.58% in 2017.

Employment expenses in the Water collection, treatment and supply industry grew by 3.97% on the year to BGN 220,011,000 in 2016.



The highest growth in labour costs, of 3.97%, was registered by Water collection, treatment and supply.

The monthly costs per employee in the Water collection, treatment and supply industry averaged BGN 1,087 in 2016, BGN 662 in 2015 and BGN 1,012 in 2014.

The monthly social security costs per employee in the industry averaged BGN 228 in 2016, versus BGN 139 in 2015 and BGN 208 in 2014.




The industry's tax expenses stood at BGN 3,493,000 in 2016. In 2015 it paid taxes of BGN 3,672,000. In 2014 the industry paid BGN 3,011,000 in taxes.



V. PROFITABILITY

The industry's net profit amounted to BGN 30,881,000 in

2016, compared to a net profit of BGN 28,947,000 in 2015 and a net profit of BGN 12,247,000 in 2014.



The combined operating earnings of the companies in the Water collection, treatment and supply field rose by 6.83% y/y to BGN 34,374,000 in 2016.

The profit margin for the Water collection, treatment and supply industry stood at 4.99% in 2016, while in 2015 it amounted to 4.85% and 2.38% in 2014.

The Water collection, treatment and supply industry's return on equity (ROE) is 9.76% compared to 5.00% in 2015 and 2.18% in 2014.

The Water collection, treatment and supply's return on assets (ROA) was 3.53%, while in 2015 it amounted to 2.48% and 1.05% in 2014.

About 10.00% of the 10 leading companies in terms of net profit per employee are located in SOFIA, while 10.00% are BURGAS-based and 10.00% are headquartered in RUSE.

The average net sales revenue per employee in the Water collection, treatment and supply industry amounted to BGN 35,514 in 2016, up by 64.06% compared to 2015 and up by 9.77% compared to 2014.

The industry's average operating revenue per employee went up by 63.93% year-on-year in 2016 to BGN 40,862. It grew by 9.56% compared to 2014.

The Water collection, treatment and supply market generated an average BGN 41,177 in total revenue per employee. In 2015 and 2014 the figure was BGN 25,275 and BGN 37,716, respectively.

The average total revenue per company in the Water collection, treatment and supply industry grew to BGN 10,681,231 in 2016 from BGN 9,752,377 in 2015. The 2014 value was BGN 8,453,250.

A company in the Water collection, treatment and supply market made on average a net sales revenue of BGN 9,212,215 in 2016, compared to BGN 8,352,609 in 2015 and BGN 7,251,487 in 2014.

The Water collection, treatment and supply industry made 0.24% of the overall sales country-wide, rising its market share by 0.01 pp.

Operating profit per employee for the industry as a whole was BGN 2,039 in 2016. For comparison in 2015 it amounted to BGN 1,209 and BGN 1,209 in 2014.

The total indebtedness of the companies in the Water collection, treatment and supply industry was BGN 537,724,000 versus BGN 391,793,000 a year ago. In 2014 the industry's indebtedness totalled BGN 407,312,000.

Debt-to-assets ratio of the companies in the industry is 0.62 in 2016. It was 0.34 in 2015 and 0.35 in 2014.

According to market experts, the greatest impact on the


development of the Water collection, treatment and supply industry has accounting profit / loss. In 2016 it stood at BGN 0, according to the financial statements of the companies in the industry.

VI. EMPLOYMENT

A total of 16,861 people were employed in the Water collection, treatment and supply market at the end of 2016, compared to 26,624 in 2015 and 17,034 in 2014.

The analysis on companies' sizes by the number of employees, shows that 20 firms have less than 50 employees*, 13 have between 50 and 250 employees* and 27 companies employ more than 250*.

* Companies without data in the number of employees at end of the year are not taken into consideration.



The employees of the leading 10 companies when it comes to numbers make up 52.52% of the workforce in the industry in 2016.

The Water collection, treatment and supply industry is the 30th largest employer in the country with 16,861 employees with the largest employer being Retail trade, except of motor vehicles and motorcycles with 234,189 and Libraries, archives, museums and other cultural activities at the bottom with 54

employees.

The Water collection, treatment and supply's share in the country's total employment was 0.73% in 2016, 1.34% in 2015 and 0.92% in 2014.

We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the number of employees of the Water collection, treatment and supply industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of -0.51% in 2017.
