


I. KEY INDICATORS

- The Creative, arts and entertainment activities industry in Romania was represented by 2,760 companies at the end of 2016, compared to 2,166 in the previous year and 1,802 in 2014.
- The industry's net profit amounted to RON 90,854,308 in 2016.
- The industry's total revenue was RON 599,958,638 in 2016, up by 28.01% compared to the previous year.
- The combined costs of the companies in the Creative, arts and entertainment activities industry reached RON 496,316,841 in 2016, up by 27.91% year-on-year.
- The industry's total revenue makes up 0.06% to the country's Gross domestic product (GDP) in 2016, compared to 0.05% for 2015 and 0.04% in 2014.
- A total of 3,091 people were employed in the Creative, arts and entertainment activities industry in 2016, compared to 2,719 in 2015 and 2,192 in 2014.
- Most of the companies in the industry are based in Bucharest, followed by Ilfov and Cluj.

II. INTRODUCTION

In 2016 the companies in the Creative, arts and entertainment activities industry numbered 2,760, distributed in 4 sectors.






In 2015 there were a total of 2,166 companies operating in the industry. In 2014 their number totalled 1,802.

III. REVENUES

The total revenue in the industry was RON 599,958,638 in 2016, RON 468,699,350 in 2015 and 337,916,277 in 2014.




The companies in the Creative, arts and entertainment activities market of Romania earned combined net sales revenues of RON 582,880,847 in 2016.

In annual terms, sales marked a growth of 29.40% compared to 2015. In comparison to 2014 they rose by 78.93%. In 2015 sales rose by 38.28% year-on-year.

The Creative, arts and entertainment activities industry total revenue make up 0.06% to the country's GDP in 2016, compared to 0.05% for 2015 and 0.04% in 2014.



IV. EXPENSES


The combined costs of the companies in the Creative, arts and entertainment activities industry reached RON 496,316,841 in 2016.

In annual terms, total expenses went up by 27.91% compared to 2015 and rose by 65.73% in comparison to 2014.

We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the total costs of the Creative, arts and entertainment activities industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 28.74% in 2017.

Operation of arts facilities marked the highest annual increase in total expenses, of 68.45%.

The biggest spenders in the industry, with costs of over 10% of industry's costs, numbered 21, including H.B. MEDIA ENTERTAINMENT SRL, EAST EUROPEAN PRODUCTION SRL, COOL PROMOTIONS SRL, SUNFEST SRL, BESTMUSIC LIVE SRL. The medium spenders, or those in the 5% and 10% range count 42 and include LOUD MUSIC ENTERTAINMENT SRL, STALEX PR & MEDIA EVENTS SRL, RIVULUS DOMINARUM FILM SRL, MABEL CONCERT SRL, ATELIER IDEEA CONCEPT SRL. Below 5% threshhold are 2,697 companies, including ROLL OUT FILM SRL, COSMOPLAN PROIECT CONSULT SRL, PROTON BAND SRL-D, GIO ADYDAL 2014 SRL, NEXT BUSINESS CLASS INTERNATIONAL SRL.

Employment expenses in the Creative, arts and entertainment activities industry increased by 32.03% on the year to RON 53,723,954 in 2016.

The highest growth in labour costs, of 65.58%, was registered by Operation of arts facilities.

The monthly costs per employee in the Creative, arts and entertainment activities industry averaged RON 1,448 in 2016, RON 1,247 in 2015 and RON 1,160 in 2014.



arts and entertainment activities industry amounted to RON 188,574 in 2016, up by 13.82% compared to 2015 and up by 26.89% compared to 2014.

The Creative, arts and entertainment activities sector generated an average RON 194,099 in total revenue per employee. In 2015 and 2014 the figure was RON 172,379 and RON 154,159, respectively.

The average total revenue per company in the Creative, arts and entertainment activities industry went up to RON 217,376 in 2016 from RON 216,389 in 2015. The 2014 value was RON 187,523.

A company in the Creative, arts and entertainment activities industry made on average a net sales revenue of RON 211,189 in 2016, compared to RON 207,968 in 2015 and RON 180,777 in 2014.

The Creative, arts and entertainment activities industry made 0.05% of the overall sales country-wide, increasing its market share by 0.01 pp.


