

I. KEY INDICATORS

- The Libraries, archives, museums and other cultural activities industry in Romania was represented by 284 companies at the end of 2016, compared to 264 in the previous year and 238 in 2014.
- The industry's net profit amounted to RON 38,075,512 in 2016.
- The industry's total revenue was RON 204,674,121 in 2016, up by 10.54% compared to the previous year.
- The combined costs of the companies in the Libraries, archives, museums and other cultural activities industry reached RON 159,507,581 in 2016, up by 9.70% year-on-year.
- The industry's total revenue makes up 0.02% to the country's Gross domestic product (GDP) in 2016, compared to 0.02% for 2015 and 0.02% in 2014.
- A total of 1,826 people were employed in the Libraries, archives, museums and other cultural activities industry in 2016, compared to 1,658 in 2015 and 1,435 in 2014.
- Most of the companies in the industry are based in Bucharest, followed by lasi and Mures.

II. INTRODUCTION

In 2016 the companies in the Libraries, archives, museums and other cultural activities industry numbered 284, distributed in 4 sectors.



INDUSTRY STRUCTURE BY SECTORS AND NUMBER OF COMPANIES


In 2015 there were a total of 264 companies operating in the industry. In 2014 their number totalled 238.

III. REVENUES


The total revenue in the industry was RON 204,674,121 in 2016, RON 185,160,226 in 2015 and 166,490,760 in 2014.



The companies in the Libraries, archives, museums and other cultural activities market of Romania earned combined net sales revenues of RON 193,844,916 in 2016.

In annual terms, sales marked an increase of 10.21% compared to 2015. In comparison to 2014 they grew by 20.12%. In 2015 sales rose by 9.00% year-on-year.


The Libraries, archives, museums and other cultural activities industry total revenue make up 0.02% to the country's GDP in 2016, compared to 0.02% for 2015 and 0.02% in 2014.



We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the total revenue of the Libraries, archives, museums and other cultural activities industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 10.88% in 2017.

IV. EXPENSES

The combined costs of the companies in the Libraries, archives, museums and other cultural activities industry reached RON 159,507,581 in 2016.


In annual terms, total expenses went up by 9.70% compared to 2015 and rose by 23.55% in comparison to 2014.

We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the total costs of the Libraries, archives, museums and other cultural activities industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 11.15% in 2017.

Library and archives activities marked the highest annual growth in total expenses, of 15.68%, while total expenses went down the most, by 1.95%, for Operation of historical sites and buildings and similar visitor attractions.

The biggest spenders in the industry, with costs of over 10% of industry's costs, numbered 9, including CAROLIN SRL, TURDA SALINA DURGAU SA, IRON MOUNTAIN SRL, GLOBAL ARCHIVE MANAGEMENT SRL, COMPANIA DE ADMINISTRARE A DOMENIULUI BRAN SRL. The medium spenders, or those in the 5% and 10% range count 2 and include RIBEIT SRL, SISTEC CONFIDENTIAL SRL. Below 5% threshold are 273 companies, including ASSAYS SOLUTIONS SRL, CASA SERVICIILOR ARHIVISTICE SRL, ARHIVE LOGISTIC BANAT SRL, SIM'ART CONSTRUCT SRL, OPTIM ARHIV SRL.

Employment expenses in the Libraries, archives, museums and other cultural activities industry increased by 17.22% on the year to RON 53,095,161 in 2016.

The highest growth in labour costs, of 21.95%, was registered by Library and archives activities.

The monthly costs per employee in the Libraries, archives, museums and other cultural activities industry averaged RON 2,423 in 2016, RON 2,277 in 2015 and RON 2,207 in 2014.



About 20.00% of the 10 leading companies in terms of net profit per employee are located in Suceava, while 20.00% are Mures-based and 10.00% are headquartered in Bucharest.

The average net sales revenue per employee in the Libraries, archives, museums and other cultural activities industry amounted to RON 106,158 in 2016, up by 0.07% compared to

2015 and down by 5.60% compared to 2014.

The Libraries, archives, museums and other cultural activities industry generated an average RON 112,089 in total revenue per employee. In 2015 and 2014 the figure was RON 111,677 and RON 116,021, respectively.

The average total revenue per company in the Libraries, archives, museums and other cultural activities industry went up to RON 720,684 in 2016 from RON 701,364 in 2015. The 2014 value was RON 699,541.

A company in the Libraries, archives, museums and other cultural activities field made on average a net sales revenue of RON 682,553 in 2016, compared to RON 666,247 in 2015 and RON 678,035 in 2014.

The Libraries, archives, museums and other cultural activities industry made 0.02% of the overall sales country-wide.


