
I. KEY INDICATORS


- The Printing and reproduction of recorded media industry in Romania was represented by 2,163 companies at the end of 2016, compared to 2,169 in the previous year and 2,033 in 2014.
- The industry's net profit amounted to RON 384,629,487 in 2016.
- The industry's total revenue was RON 3,496,288,782 in 2016, up by 5.03% compared to the previous year.
- The combined costs of the companies in the Printing and reproduction of recorded media industry reached RON 3,043,256,701 in 2016, up by 4.72% year-on-year.
- The industry's total revenue makes up 0.38% to the country's Gross domestic product (GDP) in 2016, compared to 0.39% for 2015 and 0.36% in 2014.
- A total of 14,989 people were employed in the Printing and reproduction of recorded media industry in 2016, compared to 14,785 in 2015 and 13,661 in 2014.
- Most of the companies in the industry are based in Bucharest, followed by Cluj and Ilfov.

II. INTRODUCTION

In 2016 the companies in the Printing and reproduction of recorded media industry numbered 2,163, distributed in 5 sectors.









III. REVENUES


The total revenue in the industry was RON 3,496,288,782 in 2016, RON 3,328,864,155 in 2015 and 2,950,596,589 in 2014.



The companies in the Printing and reproduction of recorded media market of Romania earned combined net sales revenues of RON 3,345,732,751 in 2016.

In annual terms, sales marked a growth of 5.57% compared to 2015. In comparison to 2014 they went up by 16.47%. In 2015 sales grew by 10.32% year-on-year.

The Printing and reproduction of recorded media industry total revenue make up 0.38% to the country's GDP in 2016, compared to 0.39% for 2015 and 0.36% in 2014.




We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the total revenue of the Printing and reproduction of recorded media industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 8.86% in 2017.

IV. EXPENSES

The combined costs of the companies in the Printing and reproduction of recorded media industry reached RON 3,043,256,701 in 2016.


In annual terms, total expenses went up by 4.72% compared to 2015 and increased by 13.13% in comparison to 2014.

We expect, based on the trend in the last three years, the total costs of the Printing and reproduction of recorded media industry to change at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 6.36% in 2017.

Binding and related services marked the highest annual growth in total expenses, of 15.16%, while total expenses decreased the most, by 4.61%, for Printing of newspapers.

The biggest spenders in the industry, with costs of over 10% of industry's costs, numbered 30, including EDS ROMANIA SRL, ART GROUP INT SRL, MEGA PRESS HOLDINGS SA, RODATA SRL, TIPOGRAFIA EVEREST 2001 SRL. The medium spenders, or those in the 5% and 10% range count 22 and include ABSOLUT SRL, USPRINT GROUP SRL, B.N. COM SRL, INKORPORATE PRINT SRL, CRIST 1 SRL. Below 5% threshhold are 2,111 companies, including PRINT-ONLINE SRL, TIPO BOMI SRL, PAPER PRINT INVEST SA, DRAGADOR SRL, COLORPRINT SRL.

Employment expenses in the Printing and reproduction of recorded media industry increased by 14.16% on the year to RON 517,206,261 in 2016.

The highest growth in labour costs, of 22.12%, was registered by Reproduction of recorded media.

The monthly costs per employee in the Printing and reproduction of recorded media industry averaged RON 2,875 in 2016, RON 2,554 in 2015 and RON 2,277 in 2014.







The Printing and reproduction of recorded media's return on assets (ROA) was 9.70%, while in 2015 it amounted to 9.14% and 6.22% in 2014.

About 40.00% of the 10 leading companies in terms of net profit per employee are located in Bucharest, while 10.00% are Ilfov-based and 10.00% are headquartered in Giurgiu.

The average net sales revenue per employee in the Printing and reproduction of recorded media industry amounted to RON 223,213 in 2016, up by 4.13% compared to 2015 and up by 6.15% compared to 2014.

The Printing and reproduction of recorded media market generated an average RON 233,257 in total revenue per employee. In 2015 and 2014 the figure was RON 225,151 and RON 215,987, respectively.

The average total revenue per company in the Printing and reproduction of recorded media industry went up to RON 1,616,407 in 2016 from RON 1,534,746 in 2015. The 2014 value was RON 1,451,351.

A company in the Printing and reproduction of recorded media sector made on average a net sales revenue of RON 1,546,802 in 2016, compared to RON 1,461,151 in 2015 and RON 1,413.052 in 2014.

The Printing and reproduction of recorded media industry made 0.28% of the overall sales country-wide.


